#### Golf Balls Belong on the Golf Course

Last winter and now recently again several golf balls have appeared on the frozen pond near the Dowell Road entrance to our subdivision. While the golf balls themselves are harmless to the pond and the wildlife within, they do potentially create a hazardous situation for anyone who may attempt to retrieve them from the pond

We don't want to see anyone, especially small children or pets, fall through thin ice on the pond while attempting to retrieve a ball. We ask that you refrain from putting any more golf balls on any of the ponds in the Prairie Woods subdivision.

### **Pulte Homes Updates**

As Renee mentioned in her President's Message, Pulte Homes has already sold several lots. Many of those lots have been prepped for construction with the installation of silt screens around the future construction sites. Pulte has indicated that construction will likely begin in January 2022. Construction crews are normally allowed to work between 7 am and 7 pm unless a special permit has been obtained.

Naturally, there may be some issues for current residents during the construction of these new homes. Should you have any issue with any of Pulte's construction crew(s) or any future SR Jacobsen issues please address your concern(s) with the Board. We will reach out to Pulte or SR Jacobsen to attempt to resolve your issue.

You should contact the Island Lake Police Department for assistance with parking problems, construction start times, or any other issue which requires immediate assistance.

### Friendly Neighborhood Reminders

- ❖ The posted speed limit throughout Prairie Woods is 20 MPH. With potential ice and snow on the roadways that speed may be too fast. Please adjust your speed as needed.
- ❖ As mentioned earlier, snow removal from the sidewalks is a resident's responsibility. Please consider giving your elderly neighbors a helping hand with this task.
- ❖ All Island Lake residents should have received a "friendly" reminder that they will see a 50% increase on their water bills as the price for water has increased from \$5.00 per thousand gallons to \$7.50 per thousand gallons. This new rate is effective January 1, 2022. Now is the time to start planning your conservation strategy.
